

ENFORCEMENT NOTICE TO TAKE SPECIFIED STEPS IN RELATION TO A BREACH/ANTICIPATED BREACH OF PERMIT CONDITION(S)

Environmental permit: EPR/BL9518IE Regulated facility: Jameson Road Phase 2 Landfill Site, Jameson Road, Fleetwood, Lancashire, FY7 8TW

The Environment Agency considers that the following condition of the environmental permit is being contravened:

2.10.1 The operator shall take appropriate measures, including, but not limited to, those specified in any approved landfill gas management plan, to (a) collect landfill gas; and (b) control the migration of landfill gas.

Because you are not taking all appropriate measures to collect landfill gas in Cells 1 & 5.

In particular:

- a) The landfill gas management plan has not been revised to account for the current operation of the landfill.
- b) The flanks of Cells 1 & 5 are inadequately covered to prevent the emission of landfill gas.
- c) The uncapped areas of Cells 1 & 5 are producing landfill gas which is not being effectively collected in the landfill gas management system.

You are required to take the steps set out in Schedule 1 by the date specified in order to remedy the contravention.

General

- 1. Failure to comply with this notice is an offence under Regulation 38(3) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 and may result in legal action being taken against you.
- 2. Without prejudice to the requirements of this notice, failure to comply with a condition of an environmental permit is an offence and may result in legal action being taken against you.
- 3. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

Appeal provisions

You are entitled to appeal against this notice under Regulation 31(1)(f) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016. Notice of appeal must be made within two months of the date of this notice. An appeal does not affect the requirements of this notice.

You must send written notice of the appeal and the documents listed below to:

At the same time, you must send a copy of the appeal notice and documents to us.

The required documents are:

- a statement of the grounds of appeal;
- a copy of any relevant application;
- a copy of any relevant environmental permit;
- a copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator;
- a copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal; and
- a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying the Secretary of State in writing and sending a copy of that notification to us.

Further information about making an appeal and the forms that you will need are available from the Planning Inspectorate.

In addition, you can request an independent internal review of our decision to issue this notice. Asking us to review our decision will not affect the time limits within which any statutory appeal must be made. We expect any request to review a regulatory decision to be made promptly, usually within 14 days.

2.10.1	 Install engineered temporary capping on: the part of the flank of cell 1 from which temporary capping has been removed, and the flank of cell 5 adjacent to cells 6 & 8, as shown marked in red on the indicative plan "<i>Jameson Road uncapped flanks</i>" attached to this notice. The engineered temporary cap shall be capable of preventing air ingress to the waste mass and minimising odour emissions for a period of at least 12 months. The cap must be made of a material that is physically and 	15 May 2024
	chemically suitable for use as a temporary cap and the design and construction must be in accordance with Environment Agency guidance document: " <u>LFE4 -</u> <u>Earthworks in landfill engineering.</u> "
