Current Situation

We have seen an increase in odour reports over the last 24-48 hours. We have officers out within the community today and will follow-up with Transwaste to find out why this may be happening. We will provide another update by the end of next week (19 July) when we have more details.

Regulatory enforcement

You will be aware that we served Transwaste with a [Regulation 37 Enforcement Notice](#) on 24 May, suspending the acceptance of waste onto the site and requiring further work to be delivered by Transwaste at Jameson Road by 9 July.

As required by the suspension notice, we carried out our inspection at Jameson Road on 10 July and following this inspection **we have not lifted the suspension notice** at this time.

While much of the work to cover the problem area of the site has been done, we need assurances that it is completed to the required standard. We will continue to monitor progress on site and ensure that Transwaste remains compliant with the suspension notice. The acceptance of waste on to the site is still not permitted and this will remain in place until we are satisfied.

Our priority remains minimising off-site odour issues. We understand how unpleasant the recent odour issues have been and we are committed to ensuring that Transwaste make the necessary improvements for residents and the environment.

We will continue to keep the community updated as the situation changes, by way of this newsletter and by keeping our [dedicated page](#) up to date.

Next Steps

Subject to us withdrawing the suspension notice at the point we are satisfied that Transwaste have complied, we will continue to maintain an **increased level** of regulation at the landfill.

- leachate management,

We will also place a high level of scrutiny on the engineering, construction and operation in the newest landfill cell.
