Regulatory enforcement

We served Transwaste with a <u>Regulation 37 Enforcement Notice</u> on 24 May suspending the acceptance of waste onto the site and we require further work to be delivered by Transwaste.

The Suspension Notice and Requirement to take steps is still in place, and Transwaste have been given until 5pm on 9 July to comply with the notice. Our site inspections confirm that Transwaste is continuing works to cap the problem areas of the site.

Our officers are maintaining odour checks and drone flights in the vicinity, and we welcome members of the public to continue to report odours and concerns they might have in regard to the operations on site.

If Transwaste meets the requirements set out in Schedule 2, the suspension notice will be lifted. However, our priority remains minimising off-site odour issues, and this decision would be taken following a robust and detailed inspection.

If significant odour problems persist even after the operator complies with the notice, we may take further steps, including a further suspension on waste acceptance at the site.

We have been asked by members of the public to share more detail on our inspections at the site; we will be able to share more detail by the end of July. All inspection reports that would form part of any public register information will be published on our dedicated webpage at:
