Welcome!

Benches and planters

As we move through the stages of the project, we will safely store the benches and plant pots along the seafront.

During the works at Thorney Bay, we are working with Councillor Palmer and Councillor Campagna at Castle Point Borough Council who are liaising with friends and family where they can. We will safely store the benches at Thorney Bay, leave the plants where they are and protect and water them as necessary.

We will also remove the benches at Beveland Road to a safe place when we start work.

Progress from site

Since we last updated you, we have:

- Set up Compound 4 situated to the east of Beveland Road.
- Connected our Main Compound to the mains electricity. This will reduce the need for a generator, which will reduce the noise impact. It has also been surfaced with tarmac.
- The archaeological investigations were completed. We will liaise with Historic England regarding next steps.

In the coming weeks, our work will include the following:

- We are installing debris netting on the Heras fencing on the Lower Haul Road between the Main Compound and Compound 4. This will help to minimise any dust on the road.
- Jet washing of the revetment in the Thorney Bay area to remove any seaweed and debris. This needs to be removed before we lay the new revetement.
- We are starting the first stage of revetment renewal and improvement with placing of Open Stone Asphalt in the Thorney Bay area. Please see page three for the working hours.
- Preparatory works will start on the riverward walkway between Thorney Bay and the Welcome Hut. We will be replacing walkway slabs which have settled to remove future trip hazards. We have closed the landward footpath to allow the construction of a temporary working platform.

Canvey Kehilla visit

Dave Gauntlett and Param Kaur-Kingston from TEAM2100 recently met with Joel Friedman and Mike Gold from the Canvey Kehilla Jewish Centre.

The meeting provided the Canvey Kehilla team with an update on the project and its benefits to Canvey Island. It also gave Joel and Mike the chance to ask wider questions regarding flood risk on Canvey Island.

Working with the community

- The project team took part in a litter pick on Monday 27 March. The team worked across the land and seafront of the 3km stretch at Canvey where we will be renewing and improving the erosion protection on the seaward face of the tidal defences.



- We are making 'bug hotels' for Leigh Beck Infant, Nursey and Junior Schools and Lubbins Park Primary School. The school children will use them to increase their understanding of wildlife.
- We received a request for additional dog waste bins near our site between the Main Compound and Compound 4. We have requested this via the council and they are looking at locations.

Footpath diversion at Fisherman's Corner

We are carrying out preparatory and repair works to the revetment, and this means we need to close the coastal path and riverside walkway at Fisherman's Corner for 12 months.

This will also involve operations on the landward side of the defence to support movement of materials.
