## **Progress from site**

Over the past month we have:

- Started to place Open Stone Asphalt (OSA) and Lean Sand Asphalt (LSA) in front of the Labworth Café area.
- Continued with the ramp construction at Fisherman's Corner.
- Completed the construction of three sets of pre-cast concrete steps in the Thorney Bay area.
- Commenced the removal of the temporary haul road in the area of Leigh Beck.
- Commenced construction of a temporary access ramp at May Avenue Pumping Station.

Work at Fisherman's Corner

- Widening the opening in the concrete tidal defence wall which allows the installation of the new flood gate at Fisherman's Corner.
- Continue with placement of OSA/LSA in the Labworth Café area.
- Starting work at Chapman Sands, including driving test piles.

#### Thorney Bay benches returned to seafront



We have removed and safely stored the benches and plant pots along the seafront as we have worked on different stages of the project.

The site team has now begun to put the memorial benches back into their original places on the seaward side at Thorney Bay. We will advise when this area with the benches is re-opened for access in a future edition of the newsletter.

The benches at Leigh Beck will also be returned in due course. The project team would like to thank everyone for their patience, understanding and cooperation. Please see the timings update below for further information on the project phases.

## 'Rockpools' created on shoreline

Three bespoke, 1m<sup>3</sup> concrete blocks have been designed in collaboration with Glasgow University and Poundfield, that provide habitat, similar to a rockpool, for organisms.


Each block includes four textured surface faces and a feature on the top face that retains water as the existing rock armour does not retain water once the tide has fallen. The textured surface provides habitat for micro-organisms to "hang on" to, such as the attachment of barnacles and seaweed, which in turn can create habitat for other species. The pool on the top side gets inundated with water at each tide, providing further variety of habitat for species that are susceptible to drying out, such as anemones.

In general, rock armour does not contain water retaining features and can be relatively poor at maximising species attachment. The benefits of these bespoke blocks is to provide this habitat and compensate for the loss of a small area of intertidal habitat as a result of the works.





### Project timings update



The latest timings for the project can be seen in the phasing diagram on the left. The diagram has recently been updated by the project team to reflect the entirety of works activity in each individual phase. We anticipate that the first sections of the Thorney Bay and Leigh Beck phases will start to be opened up to the public in February 2024.
