Canvey Island Southern Shoreline Improvements

We are renewing and improving the erosion protection on the seaward side of the local defences, known as 'groyne improvement' along 8km of the southern shoreline of Canvey Island. This will minimise the existing high level of flood risk experienced by thousands of homes and businesses, particularly those situated on Canvey Island in 2050.



A coastal defence scheme which aims to protect the coastline from flooding and erosion that is due to start in early 2025 and run until approximately 2030.

The scheme will be carried out in phases which are being developed to minimise disruption to the community and the environment. The scheme will improve the defences along the entire shoreline. Those present and areas under construction will be subject to environmental monitoring and management of the modern end of the beach.


