## **Coggeshall, Feering and Kelvedon Flood Alleviation Scheme**



Existing view of the site – The viewpoint is located on the Essex Way approximately 115m from the B1024 in Coggeshall. The view looks west along the Essex Way which is partially enclosed by a mature hedgerow. Recently planted trees are visible on the skyline. These views are similar to those experienced by residential properties along the Kelvedon Road (B1024), although westerly views from the rear of the properties are partially screened by garden vegetation. Coggeshall Grange Barn (Grade I Listed Building) is screened by an intervening hedgerows and the walled garden.

## View whilst the quarrying and restoration works are ongoing

 Prior to any quarrying operations, screening bunds would be constructed around the site.
The recently planted native woodland, which would have matured will be visible on the skyline south of the Essex Way. There would be no change to the views from this location compared to the existing situation.





View of the site 15 years post restoration – Apart from an increase in the height of the recently planted native woodland there would be no change between the Year 15 view and the existing view.
