

Coggeshall, Feering and Kelvedon Flood Alleviation Scheme



Existing view of the site – The viewpoint is located on public footpath 72/39, west of the electricity substation (near to Coggeshall Cricket Club). Rising ground to the west and southwest prevents long-distance views across the existing arable land and the majority of views into the flood storage area. The recently planted native woodland belts to the south and west of the footpath can be seen.

View whilst the quarrying and restoration works are ongoing – Prior to any quarrying operations, screening bunds would be constructed around the site. Works within Phase D would be the final phase of the quarrying operations (15 years after commencement of works within the flood storage area), by which time the recently planted woodland around the perimeter of the site would have matured to provide additional screening.



View of the site 15 years post restoration – Following restoration, the site would be returned to agricultural use. The recently planted native woodland would have matured. The view from footpath 72/39 would have a more wooded and varied character than the existing open view.
