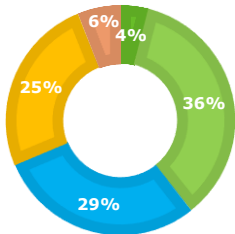

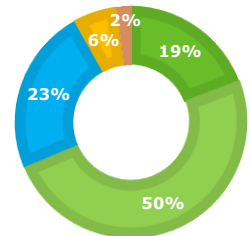

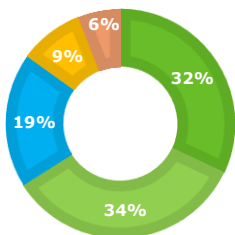


1. Beach without control structures – Annual nourishment increasing volumes to maintain same standard of protection – Present Management Option

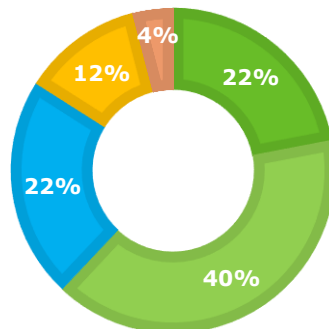

Beach nourishment with different beach material grading

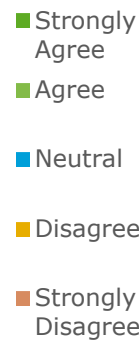
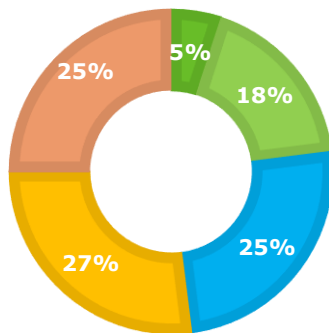

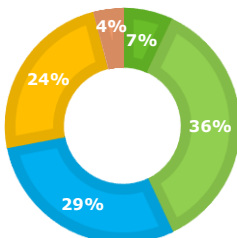


3. Beach with control structures
Rock armour groynes and beach nourishment

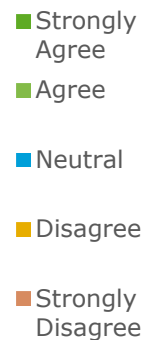
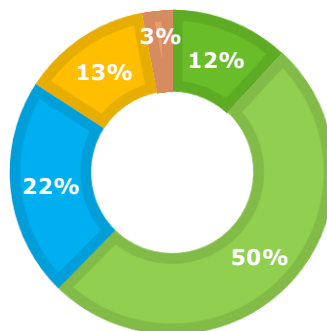

nourishment

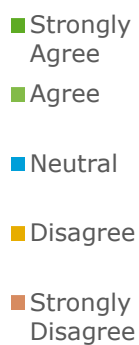
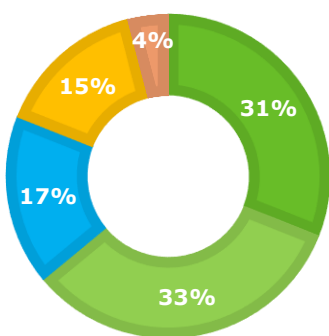

changing beach nourishment volumes

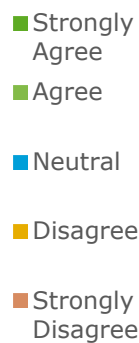
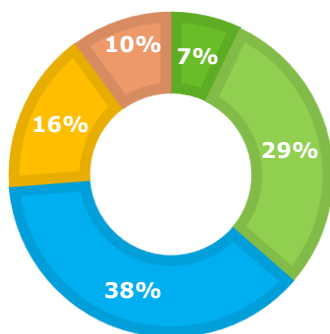

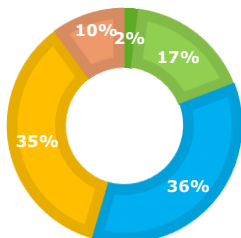


6. Beach with control structures
Rock armour structures at lower or higher standards of protection by changing beach nourishment frequency

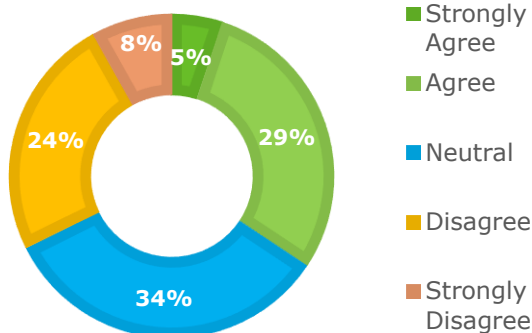

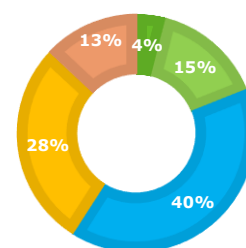
