RIVER RIBBLE ROD AND LINE BYELAW

THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY, in exercise of its powers under Section 210 of, and paragraph 6(1)(b) of Schedule 25 to, the Water Resources Act 1991, hereby makes the following Byelaws.

Maximum number of salmon that may be caught by rod and line and killed

Byelaw 1

On the River Ribble, and on all waters which are tributaries to, or connected with, the River Ribble, during the period from, and including, the 16th day of June to, and including, the 31st day of October following, no person fishing by rod and line is permitted to catch and kill more than two salmon.

Byelaw 2

Any person who has caught and killed two salmon in the circumstances set out in Byelaw 1 above may continue to fish for salmon provided that any further salmon caught are released immediately to the water from which they were caught with the least possible injury.

This byelaw shall expire 10 years after the date it comes into force.
