

The River Roding Project

Broadmead Baptist Church embankment repairs – September/October 2024

The Environment Agency are undertaking work in this area as part of the River Roding Project to reduce the risk of flooding to communities in Woodford and Ilford. The project consists of:

- a Flood Storage Area in Essex, upstream of the M25, and
- embankment repairs on the River Roding adjacent to Broadmead Baptist Church

What is happening here?

We are repairing an embankment on the River Roding which consists of the following key activities:

- Bat surveys
- Vegetation clearance
- Fence, access track and site compound set-up in the park
- Tree work
- Embankment repairs
- Reinstatement and landscaping works

When will this be happening?

Work started on surveys and vegetation clearance in the middle of September and the work is scheduled to be complete by late October 2024 with final landscaping undertaken within an appropriate weather window.
