

South Humber Developing Projects

The Environment Agency is continuing to progress three priority projects that have been indicatively allocated funding in the 2021-27 Capital Investment Programme. These projects could lead to reduced flood risk to more than 3000 properties, existing major industrial sites and significant infrastructure, as well as enterprise zones.

Stallingborough 3 – this scheme will reduce tidal flood risk between the ports of Immingham and Grimsby, by improving and maintaining existing assets, across approximately 4.5km of tidal defences along the frontage.

Barton – New Holland – the Barton to New Holland Flood Alleviation Scheme aims to adapt and improve flood defences in the area, alongside crucial work to increase resilience and reduce the impacts of tidal flooding to local communities and businesses.

Halton Marshes Phase 2 – This project will be led by North Lincolnshire Council with support from Able UK and the Environment Agency. More to come on this project soon.
