

Roxby Landfill Site - March 2022

Introduction

We are pleased to be bringing you the second Environment Agency update on our compliance work at Roxby Landfill operated by Biffa Waste Services Ltd.

Our Commitment


As part of our regulation of the site, we continue to carry out air quality/odour assessments during routine visits to the site which include both announced and unannounced visits.

Our officers are working closely with Biffa Waste Services Ltd to make sure that improvements are made, and odour nuisance is reduced to a minimum.

Latest news

- The permit breaches observed in February 2022 have since been addressed, with the improvement actions being completed by the follow up inspection.
- We have seen a significant reduction in odour reports this month, with 3 reports being received linked to the landfill.
- We have undertaken community odour monitoring twice in March, and a site inspection at Roxby Landfill. The landfill was compliant with its permit at this time.
- The latest version of the sites Odour Management Plan is due to be received by 31/03/22. We will then review its suitability and recommend any actions needed before it is accepted.
- We are in the process of undertaking a Landfill Gas Audit on the site, the purpose of this is to ensure that landfill gas is being correctly captured and that infrastructure is installed to the required standard to achieve this. This is being split into two parts, with desk-based reviews of data starting on 22/03/22. The onsite audit will take place on 27/04/22.

Regulating Biffa

We have held a meeting with Biffa's senior management team to look at their future operational plans, mentioned in our last update. They have shown clear planning on the way the remaining cell will be filled, and the rough timelines for when capping work will be completed. We have actioned Biffa to ensure permanent gas wells are installed before permanent capping starts in the north, and west side of cell 13. This will ensure the most suitable appropriate measures are in place to control odour and collect landfill gas.

Roxby Community Liaison Group

The Environment Agency meets regularly with members of the Roxby Community Liaison Group. The latest meeting was held on 4 February 2022 with representatives from North Lincolnshire Council, Winterton Town Council, Roxby-cum-Risby Parish Council, Biffa, residents, and Andrew Percy MP.
