The Mining Waste Facility Annual Report as required by permit condition 4.2.3 was submitted to the Environment Agency.

Condition 4.2.3 requires the operator, for activities A3 and A4, namely the above ground hazardous waste and non-hazardous waste facility, to submit a report on the behaviour of the mining waste facility over the previous year. In order to demonstrate compliance with this condition the report should include the results of the monitoring and assessment carried out in accordance with the conditions of the permit including the interpretive review of that data.

The performance report should include a breakdown of hazardous and non-hazardous waste quantities throughout the year and a summary of the testing carried out on each waste stream in line with the Waste Management Plan (WMP). The plan could include details of the performance of other separation of cuttings and muds through treatment on site and whether any amendments to the WMP are required. This can also include the separation of scale inhibitor.

Not all information has been provided that is required by the permit condition. Activity A4 is not included in the report. Activity A4 includes the non-hazardous mining waste facility which refers to non-hazardous extractive waste such as water based muds and drill cuttings.

The annual report does not include a breakdown of the waste quantities and types arising from the activities or an interpretive review of the data collected from sampling.

Please resubmit the report addressing the above comments by 27 August 2018.

Our assessment of permit condition 4.2.3 is not complete at this stage and we will wait until further information has been provided as requested above. A further inspection report will be produced to complete this compliance assessment.
