Cuadrilla have submitted a risk assessment and supporting evidence for revised monitoring during the well suspension period at Preston New Road. The revised monitoring reflects the reduction in operations and environmental risk at the site and is proposed to start on 6 January 2020. The site is not currently operational.

Environment Agency Specialists have assessed the proposed monitoring plan and we approve the changes to the monitoring specified in condition 3.5.1 of the permit. We expect the monitoring to resume 4 weeks prior to any changes to the operational profile of the site.

Reporting of the monitoring results to the EA will be undertaken quarterly for surface water and groundwater and 4-monthly for fugitive methane (air monitoring). Fortnightly reporting of air monitoring data (as set out in the Environmental Management and Monitoring Plan) will cease until further notice. As stated above, the position will be reviewed in the event of notification of any changes to the operational profile of the site.
