Operations at Third Energy's KM8 well

Update, October 2018

Ongoing Regulation

Ongoing regulation of Third Energy remains in place. Due to the delay in the company's plans, we have agreed a reduced suite of monitoring while there is no hydraulic fracturing equipment or chemicals on site. Before they can commence hydraulic fracturing operations they will need to carry out 3 months of groundwater monitoring. Operator air monitoring is currently suspended.

We continue to visit the KM8 site and to work with our partner regulators. This is to carry out checks on site to ensure continued compliance with the environmental permit. We will continue to publish our inspection records on Citizenspace, Environment Agency Kirby Misperton (KM8 Well) information page.

Please note that there is a delay to uploading documents to the Citizenspace page following our visits. This is in line with the Regulator's Code and we aim to make things publicly available as soon as possible.

We will provide another update to you on our regulation of KM8 if there are major changes to the current agreements in place.

EA Ambient Air Monitoring

Our Environment Agency ambient air monitoring kit on the KM8 wellpad has now been on site for well over a year. We have been on site regularly to ensure it is calibrated and working effectively. We are due to carry out servicing and maintenance on the analysers and will be removing this kit from site in the very near future. It is likely that this will then be relocated elsewhere for the moment.

We are reviewing the large quantity of data we have collected during baseline and initial pre-operational activity. We will publish a report and findings by the end of this year. This report will be made available on the KM8 Citizenspace webpage.
