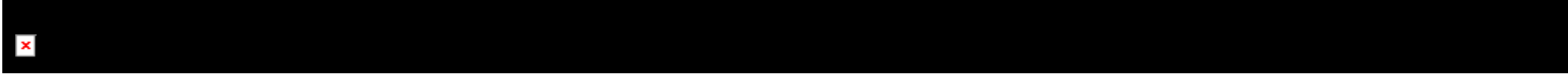

I'm writing to let you know that your application is duly made as of 19/04/23. 'Duly made' means that we have all the information we need to start determination. Determination is where we assess and make a decision on your application.

During periods of high workload we may not be able to start determination straight away. However, your application will be allocated to a determining officer as soon as possible. Once allocated, the officer will contact you to let you know.

We want to give you a decision as quickly as possible. Once the officer has familiarised themselves with your application, they'll be able to give

an estimate of timescales.

The determination time will depend on a number of factors, such as:

- the complexity of the application
- whether we need to consult. See [Environmental permits: when and how we consult](#) for a list of applications that require public consultation.
- whether we need to ask you for further information so we can complete determination. If we do need further information, we'll contact you during determination. We'll explain what information we need and how long you have to provide it.
