Hi Richard,

As just discussed, NAT tool advises that NIA NMP required for this application. The reason is due to the increase in annual throughput they have asked for. This covers campaign basis waste types coming through either hazardous or non-hazardous. There is no change in kit, operating hours, storage, or process.

The permit has NIA NMP based on 215,000 tonnes through put and operator advises this should still stand.

I agree and am happy that this application does not require NIA NMP or associated fee.
