Plastic	Plastic - feed bags, buckets, chemical containers	Approx. 18kg waste plastic is produced per week.	Make a conscientious effort to buy in products in either recyclable materials, e.g. paper, card, or recycled plastic and reduced packaging.	A waste collection contract is in place to collect up to 60kg of waste every 2 weeks, but realistically about 40kg of waste is produced (a mixture of plastic and paper)
Packaging from feed etc	Cardboard/ paper	Approx. 2kg of waste paper / cardboard is produced per week	Cardboard or waste paper is used as bedding or toys/ enrichment for the pigs	The business can't always buy in bulk due to pest management but where possible, the business will buy in larger quantities to reduce waste packaging.
Tractors & Machinery	Tyres	Currently un-monitored	The business already re-uses old tyres on silage pit as weights for cover.	
Tractors & Machinery	Waste Oil	Up to 100 litres	Ensure vehicles are always serviced to ensure efficient use of oil. Waste Oil is re-used on farm for lubricating machinery, freeing up seized kit etc.
