Thank you for your email. Responses are as follows:

4. Please can you confirm the source of the background data used to assess air emissions in the H1 tool?
I'd put the following notes in the model but should have included them in my comments for clarity:
Data from <https://uk-air.defra.gov.uk/data/gis-mapping> for 2015 (most recent) reports annual mean PM10 as 12.2 ug/m3 and 14.66 NO2 for the closest grid reference 381500, 431500

5. Our screening shows South Pennine Moors SAC and South Pennine Moors Phase 2 SPA to be located approximately 7.8km from the site and we will need to complete a habitats assessment for these sites.

Other habitat sites, such as the SSSIs, should still be considered in the application though they do not currently attract a separate fee.

There are several Local Wildlife Sites within 2km of the site too:

- Thornybank Clough
- Houghton Hey Plantation
- Pollard Moor, Hapton Common and Bently Wood Green
- Lower House Lodges

8. Emissions of uncontaminated rainwater from the site to ground and sewer would still be considered as point source emissions for the purposes of the permit but we would not require further assessment of these discharges.

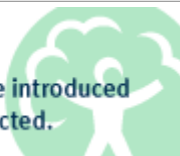
