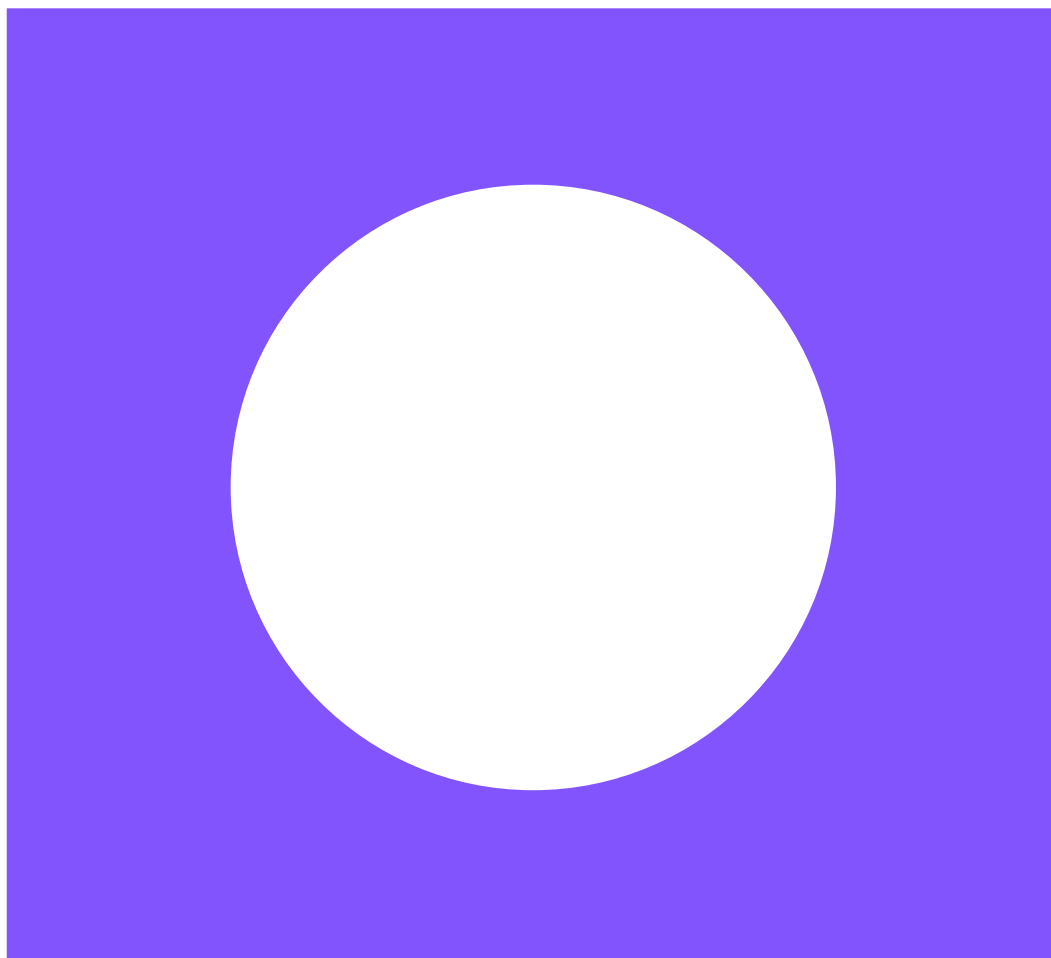

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1 Introduction

This document has been prepared by Mott MacDonald Ltd on behalf of J Suttle Transport Ltd to accompany and support the Environmental Permit application for an inert waste treatment facility and for the use of waste in restoration of Swanworth Quarry, Swanage. The operator of the facility is Suttles Stone Quarries, a trading arm of J Suttle Transport Ltd. The application is being made under the Environmental Permitting Regulations 2016¹.

This document updates the plans submitted as part of the original Environmental Permit application in 2011 and subsequent permit variation in 2018. The plans below show the location of both the consented permitted area of the main quarry (permit number (EPR/CB3030RQ) and the proposed lateral extension area.

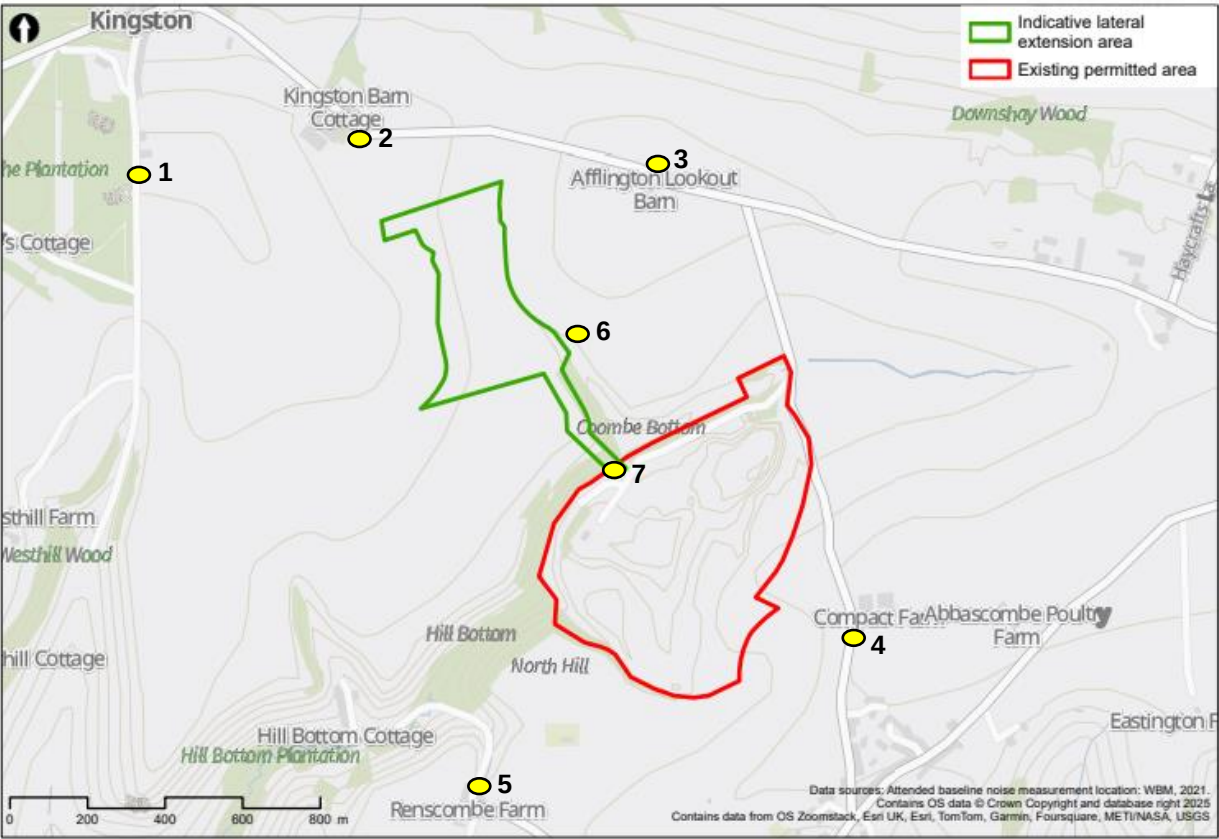
Figure 2.2: Permitted Area

Figure 2.3: Noise Monitoring Point Plan



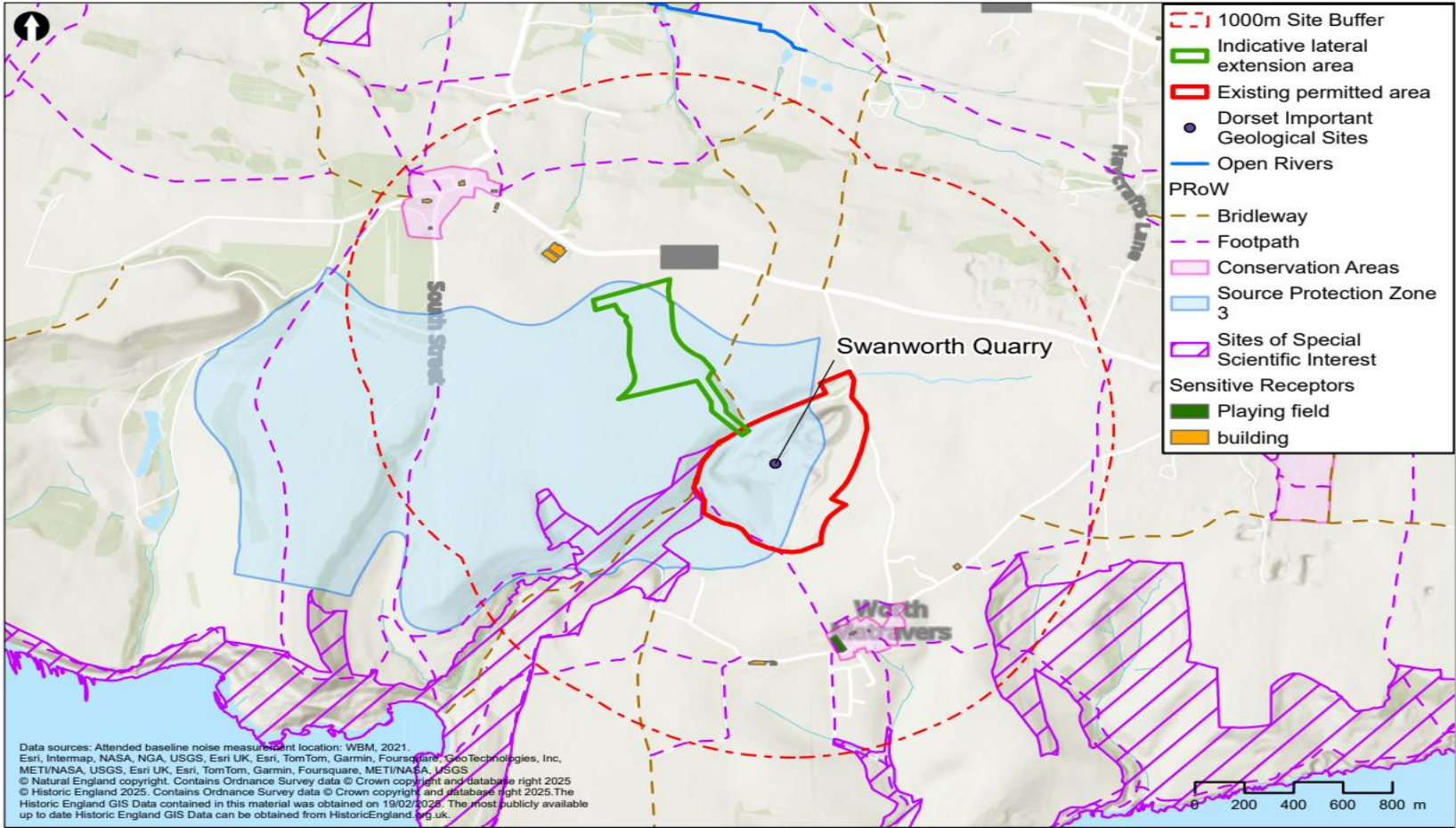

Table 2.1: Attended baseline noise measurements locations

Number	Location
1	South Street Kingston, gated field entrance between Aeolia House and Forester's Lodge
2	Kingston Barn B3069 West Street, field entrance to east of property
3	Afflington Barn Purbeck Way footpath north of B3069 West Street
4	Compact Farm, in farm yard between farm buildings and farm house
5	Renscombe Farm, on track by gate to Hill Bottom
6	Purbeck Way, near to south eastern corner of proposed extension area
7	Purpbeck way, crossing point from existing quarry to proposed extension area

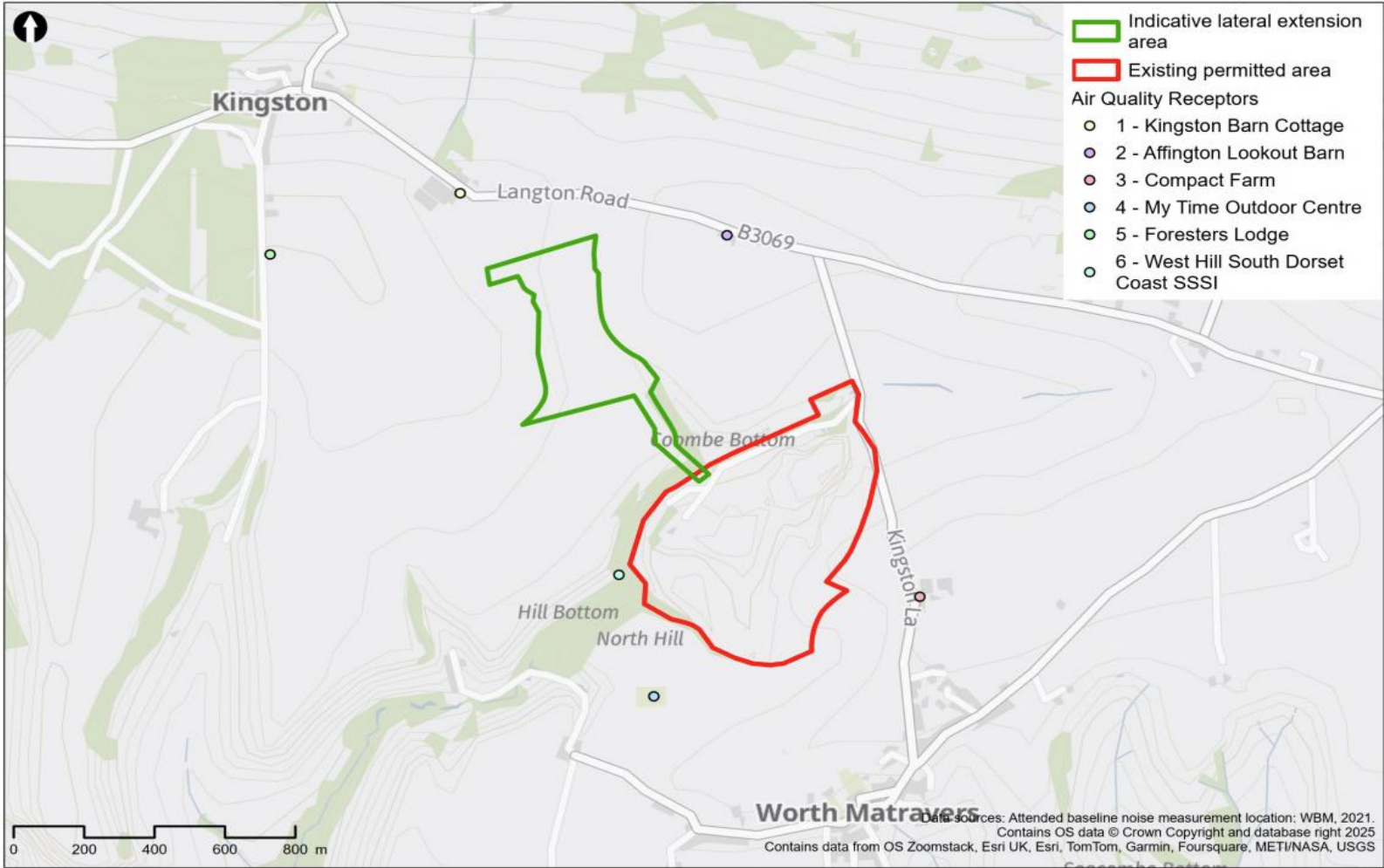
