Hi Naomi,

Following on from our meeting, please find below the requested information.

The permit application fee specified in the email titled 'Enviroo Project Co Limited Return Not Duly Made' issued on 19/01/2026 was paid for the resubmitted application. Payment of £23,702.00 was made on 20/02/2026 under payment reference number PSCAPPINSTENVIR419 and the remittance receipt provided to the Environment Agency on 24/02/2026. The payment receipt has also been attached to this email. As advised in your email on 18/03/2026 at 14:09, the fee provided by the Environment Agency was incorrect and the Operator needs to pay an additional £1,344.30. This is being discussed with the Operator.

The Noise Impact Assessment model files and Air Impact Assessment model files were sent with the not duly made response sent on 30/01/2026 and resubmitted application. The Dropbox link is below. The H1 Assessment results are attached to the report as Appendix A – Risk Assessment Calculations. As stated in the H1 Assessment modelling is not required.

The B6 forms were submitted with the not duly made response sent on 30/01/2026 and resubmitted application.

During the meeting the B3 form was requested, and this has been added to the Dropbox folder.

As we only had the meeting yesterday, we are still working on obtaining evidence of the CMS contract from the Operator. Additionally, we will send a separate email regarding the General Binding Rules query.

We trust the above answers all your questions. We look forward to discussing the application on the 23/03/2026. Please let me know if you require anything else in the meantime. We trust the above is satisfactory to allow the application to be duly made.
