

Cheshire West Recycling wishes to clarify that all activities currently authorised under Environmental Permit EPR/JB3005CJ/V002 are to remain unchanged and will continue to operate in accordance with the existing permit conditions.

This variation does not seek to reduce or replace the existing treatment activities, only increase annual tonnage allowance undertaken within the Materials Recycling Facility (MRF). Existing authorised activities, including mechanical screening, manual sorting, glass breaker, baling of currently permitted waste streams, will continue as currently permitted.

The purpose of this variation is to:

- Extend the permitted operational boundary to incorporate the areas currently operated under the S1 and S2 Waste Exemptions, bringing all these activities within the Environmental Permit.
- Include the additional hazardous and non-hazardous waste types proposed within this application.
- Authorise the transfer and bulking-up of the additional waste streams where no treatment is proposed exempt for those stated in Appendix 30.
- Authorise the additional treatment activities detailed within Appendix 30, namely:
 - Repair, refurbishment and preparation for reuse of suitable Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (equivalent to the activities undertaken under a T11 exemption). (to be sold on in the reuse shops)
 - Treatment of waste aerosol cans (equivalent to the activities undertaken under a T15 exemption).
- Extend the existing baling operations to include plastic film, in addition to the currently authorised baling activities. (if not already permitted)

Unless specifically identified above or within Appendix 30, the additional waste streams proposed under this variation are intended for transfer and bulking-up only and will not be subjected to treatment unless stated in current permit or of that requested in Appendix 30.
