This condition allows for a written agreement to change under condition 2.1.1 for the described operational changes to

i. remove the electrostatic precipitator which has been out of operation for 15 years

ii. remove the GTOA distillation column and relevant equipment which has also been offline for a significant period of time.

The Agency agrees to the changes as described in your notification and that these changes will be implemented with immediate effect.
