


A.6 Site Photographs

The Cess/Domestic Tanker Waste Imports, where waste is delivered to the site



Sludge Import area and Sludge Buffer Tank.

From the Sludge Buffer Tank, sludge is thickened.



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Photo of the covered Primary Digester Tank in the centre (indicated by red arrow) with surrounding uncovered Secondary Digester Tank (indicated by yellow arrow).

Indigenous and imported sludge are transferred via pipework to one of the Primary Digester Tanks at the site.

Sludge is transferred to one of the Secondary Digester Tanks. Two of the Secondary Digester Tanks take the form of concentric rings surrounding two of the Primary Digester Tanks (as illustrated in the photo).

The digested sludge is received at the Secondary Digester Tank prior to transfer to the Digested Sludge Buffer Tank and then for dewatering.
