Chris,

Following on from my email yesterday, I have now finished looking at the Not Duly Making response for <u>the variation</u> too; there are some things I'd like you to clarify/ resolve please:

- Form Part C4:
 - You have provided the R/D codes for the Metals Recycling (MRS) facility but had not confirmed the treatment activities. By this I had meant the activities that would feature in the Limits of Activity section. The EMS suggests metals are only sheared; is that correct? Please confirm separately on email. Treatment activities as per the EMS would be sorting, separation, grading, baling, compacting, and cutting using hand-held equipment only, of ferrous metals or alloys and non-ferrous metals into different components for recovery.
 - The form indicates the combined throughput for the ELV and MRS facilities is 30KTPa. This figure almost matches section 1.8 in the EMS (less than 30KTpa); however, there are other throughput figures in the EMS (sections 1.1.1, 1.5, 1.7) and the submitted FPP referred to <25KTpa. Please confirm separately on email (rather than redo the EMS and FPP) the maximum throughput. Both the

EMS and FPP have been amended and for clarity)see attached), the operator is proposing a total throughput of 30,000 tonnes per annum comprising 15,000 tonnes of ELVs and 15,000 tonnes of scrap metal.

- Site condition report:
 - Confirm whether the original site condition report 3041-E relates just to the southern extension, or includes the existing part. As mentioned in the email below I'm aware the new Form part E2 refers to a new 'EB' file, which I haven't located. I have split the original SCR into two documents, BAR-3041-EA relates to the proposed extension area and BAR-3041-EB relates to the surrender area, these are also attached for you.
- Could you send a copy of the remittance to show (when) payment of the extra fees is/ was done? This will help us locate the payment. I appreciate that your client may need longer than the 5 July deadline to settle the outstanding fees due. We received an invoice from SSCL on Monday (5th July) which has been sent to the operator and I will confirm with you ASAP when this payment has been made.

Please provide responses to my questions for both the surrender and variation by Wednesday 5 July.

Further to my voicemail today, I'm writing to let you know I have started to review your response.

I noticed you submitted another Form Part E2. This still referred to the map 02B but the resubmission only included to two '02A' maps (one of both current and proposed boundary; the other of just the proposed boundary). One file name was 02B whereas the reference on the map was 02A; I conclude the reference on the map is likely to be a typo error. Can you confirm this to be the case, please?

A second observation is the Form Part E2 now gave a different reference to the Site Condition Report, but I have not been able to locate the 'EB' file. We need more information about your application and payment of extra application charge

Thank you for your application and supporting documents received between April this year and last. The following is to confirm our conversation of 9/6/23.

Unfortunately the application payment (£11,190) you sent is incorrect. The correct application charge is £17,934.20. This leaves a balance of £6,744.20 to pay.

Reason: An extra 'Metals recycling mixed metals facility' (MRS) is required to accept wastes including 17 04 C&D metals; 19 12 and 20 01 metals. The application fee for the partial surrender and the variation to the current ELV site are charged as follows:

- £4,420 normal variation for ELV
- £9,463 adding the bespoke MRS
- £1,246 NIA fee
- £1,241 FPP fee
- £779 Habitats fee
- 20% of £3,926 = £785.20 Lower risk partial surrender

This fee is being paid directly to P&SC, invoice has been requested and will be paid as soon as received from P&SC.

- Reason: The same form has been used to capture partial surrender information as well as variation proposed. There is potential the partially surrendered, remaining and extension have differing hydrogeology. It is preferable the partial surrender and extension are on separate SCR templates.
- The document refers to site plan 3041-02 and 02B but we are unable to find these. Please resend or correct the references.

For the avoidance of doubt, I have provided two separate SCRs, Ref. BAR-3041-EA is for the variation and BAR-3041-EB is for the surrender.

Q6 ERA:

Provide a revised ERA to also include:

- Risk of and mitigation from effects from site flooding (site is in the higher risk flood zones 2 and 3)
 ERA has been updated, all flood risk has been assessed and approved by the Local Planning Authority under planning app. ref. DC/21/02579. This has been added to the risk assessment table and Appendix III of the updated ERA.
- Clarity on proximity of boundary to protected woodland and impacts. Reason: It is unclear if the
