Hi Jake,

In response to your questions below.

1. Drainage plan attached. Drainage only takes clean surface/roof water. Waste is stored under a canopy/cover.
2. Updated H1 attached. Plastic is not shredded into small pieces and does not cause dust. Plastic 3cm x 3cm in size after shredding.
3. The permit boundary proposed is acceptable to the operator and allows for the required quarantine area in the yard. No other areas used for storing waste other than those identified in the FPP.
4. Waste stored onsite in the fire bay will be no more than 20T per day. The silos we have only hold up to 260T combined, so we couldn't go above the 500T limit.
5. The additional fee has been paid with the same reference number.

Hi Paul,

As discussed on the phone, we require additional information to progress your application past duly making. Your current options are:

- Continue with the application and provide the required information within 10 working days (by the 8th May). Please note that if you chose this option but are unable to provide the information by the 8th May, then we are entitled to return the application as incomplete and retain 15% of the application fee; or,
- Have the application returned with a full refund, work on the information required and resubmit the application.

Please review the information required below and let me know if you intend to provide the required information within 10 working days or want to have the application returned.

Information required

1. **Drainage plan** - Please provide a drainage plan for the proposed permit area which shows the direction of movement of surface water, the location of manhole covers and drains, and any other notable drainage features such as sumps.
2. **Risk assessment** - Your risk assessment does not include any control measures for dust emissions, and there is an incorrect reference to having an emissions management plan. You must identify how the risk of dust emissions will be reduced in your risk assessment. **If the activity will produce or process fine fractions of plastic, then you may require a dust and emissions management plan in accordance with [our guidance](#). Please confirm.**
3. **Permit boundary** - The proposed waste storage area and treatment building only form a small part of the proposed permitted area. It is in the operator's interest to limit the permitted boundary to only areas that need to be permitted. Please remove any unnecessary areas from the proposed permitted boundary, or show on a site plan what these areas shall be used for. **If additional areas of waste storage are to be included within your permit application, then the Fire Prevention Plan will require updating to reflect all waste storage areas.**
4. **Exemptions and Regulatory Position Statements** - To help us define the waste activity, please confirm any activities before or after the waste treatment which are planned to be controlled by either permit exemptions or a regulatory position statement. For instance the storage of the waste plastic after pelletising and prior to being fed into the manufacturing process is restricted to 500 tonnes of storage under the waste exemptions T4 and T9, above this tonnage a permit would be required for the storage of the waste plastic, and this would need to be part of your permit. **Again if additional areas of waste storage are to be included within your permit application, then the Fire Prevention Plan will require updating to reflect all waste storage areas.**
5. **Additional fee required** - You are required to pay an additional £1,241 for the assessment of the fire prevention plan. This is shown in our [charging scheme](#) under the charge reference 1.19.3.

If you wish to provide the information and the additional fee, please let me know and I will get this sent to you as a formal request with instructions.
