Muztrans Ltd – COSHH Waste Collection and Transfer Activities

Muztrans Ltd is applying to operate a service for the safe collection, storage, and transfer of hazardous (COSHH) waste. The aim is to provide a compliant and environmentally responsible solution for our clients while ensuring public safety and protecting the environment.

What we do

We deliver secure COSHH bins to our customers' sites (mainly within London). These bins are used by our clients to safely place hazardous materials such as oils, paints, solvents, adhesives, aerosols, acids, and contaminated rags. Document is raised clarifying what is in the bin quantities / product etc so we can take the correct Consignment note prior to collection. Once bins are full, our trained drivers collect them and transport them to Muztrans' head office.

At Our Head Office

The bins are brought to an outside fenced area outside the internal storage area shutter door, the materials are sorted and separated according to their type. Then once sealed placed in a bay inside the warehouse. Each type of material is placed into dedicated storage containers (UN approved Clip top drum Vented lids for some products) until it can be moved onward. We use safe handling practices and store waste indoors to prevent pollution, spills, or fire risks. Paper work is raised we then get a booking with the receiving waste company (normally 48 Hrs) we load the vehicle with give the driver the relevant paperwork goods are offloaded at third party recycling facility, paperwork returned to Muztrans office and up loaded on to S1GM4

Final Disposal

We do not treat or dispose of the waste ourselves. Once sorted, materials are transported to a licensed third-party recycling or disposal facility that has the appropriate permits to process hazardous waste.

Environmental Protections

Waste is stored indoors on hard-standing floors with suitable containment to prevent leaks or spills from entering drains or the wider environment. Different types of hazardous waste are kept apart to reduce the risk of chemical reactions. Waste is only stored on site for short periods (maximum of two weeks) before being transferred. All activities comply with the Duty of Care requirements and environmental regulations.

Why This Matters

Our service ensures that hazardous waste generated on construction and commercial sites is collected and managed responsibly. This reduces the likelihood of pollution, keeps workers and ensures materials are sent to authorised facilities for recycling or safe disposal.
