THE ECOLOGY SURVEY AREA

For some species and species groups, ecology surveys extended beyond the application red-line boundary where best practice guidelines required this, and where additional context was considered important. The survey reports provided within the Technical Appendices indicate where more extensive surveys were undertaken. The Ecology Survey Area shows the area where some survey work extended to.

The area of the red line boundary falling outside of the Ecology Survey Area represents the cable connection route which will be in the road, and therefore this area was scoped out as not requiring detailed survey work.


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
