Thank you for your application received on 18/02/2025. The following is to confirm our conversation of 29/05/2025.

Unfortunately the application payment you sent is incorrect. The correct application charge is £7,930 to add 1.16.14 Physical and chemical treatment of waste to the permitted activities. This leaves a balance of £855 to pay.
