Environmental Management System - Summary

The purpose of the 4R Environment Management System (EMS) is to ensure that the treatment and storage of wastes at The Old Peat Works site can be carried out responsibly and that all potential impacts are managed and reduced. The EMS implemented by 4R also seeks to identify and control the risks that the activities may pose to the environment and human health.

4R hold and successfully manage several existing environmental permits relating to mobile plant for landspreading, including several standard rules and a bespoke permit. All environmental permits require an appropriate EMS to be in place and additional permit conditions typically requires that "records demonstrating compliance with rule [1.1.1] shall be maintained." The EMS is available to all employees, management, and is freely available to all contractors and regulating officers.

The EMS ensures that all procedures are documented and decisions made are accountable. The review system allows for management to ensure that the EMS continues to provide an adequate and effective system for compliance and reduce exposure to environmental risk and to improve the environmental performance of the organisation.

This EMS follows the Environment Agency guidance contained within H6 – Environmental Management Systems, currently organised into the following sections and subsections;
