Tamara,

The final surface of the restored quarry will include areas restored to establish vegetation as per the approved scheme of restoration. This will require the upper 0.5m to be restored with suitable topsoil materials. It is proposed that suitable soils will be identified and deposited without the requirement to use other wastes to improve the quality of the growing medium. Should any such requirements be identified as the restoration scheme progresses the appropriate regulatory consents will be put in place, as necessary.
