

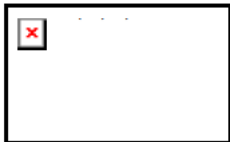

This email is regarding the Exmouth area permit applications

- 1) Maer Lane Wastewater Treatment Works (WwTW) (003174/FU/02)
- 2) Maer Lane Storm Tanks (201965)
- 3) Phear Park Pumping Station (200124)
- 4) Maer Road Pumping station (200126)

In the final response to the Request for Information submitted prior to Duly Making, the impact modelling for the outfall was provided. This modelling presented increased PFF contributions from Maer Road and Phear

Park Pumping Stations and applied continuous maximum flow conditions for a one-month period to represent the proposed Phase 1 works. At that time, it was noted that additional modelling was being undertaken to provide a more representative assessment based on typical operating conditions.

To support the robust assessment and determination of the Exmouth Area permit applications, please could you provide the results of this more representative modelling, together with any other modelling outcomes completed since 23/06/26. Access to the latest evidence base will help ensure the applications are considered using the most up-to-date and representative understanding of potential impacts.
