Dear Ms Reynolds,

Thank you for your email regarding Environmental Permit application EPR/EB3903CG/A001 for Kempsford Quarry. Please find attached the supplementary information requested for in relation to this Permit application, in addition to the below response which addresses the issues raised in your email below.

In answer to the first point you raise; 'Please complete questions 7b and 7c of the Part A form' we believe these questions were correctly answered. Question 7b asks 'who can we contact about your operation (if different from question 7a)?' - 7a is filled out and 7b is left blank because the contact is the same as 7a. Question 7c (billing and invoicing) is filled out with details for Multi-Agg Limited.

With regards to waste code 17 09 04 mixed construction and demolition wastes other than those mentioned in 17 09 01, 17 09 02 and 17 09 03, please find attached a document outlining the revised waste types for this Permit application which omits waste code 17 09 04.

Jacob Coplestone has completed his Wamitab Continuing Competence for Inert Waste Landfills and Treatment of Waste to Produce Soil, Soil Substitutes and Aggregate, however he has not been able to locate these certificates initially. He has recently ordered replacement certificates which can be provided once received. Please find attached an email thread outlining that Jacob had completed the relevant courses and was sent his Continuing Competency certificates on 28/09/2018.

Please find attached the original Wamitab qualification certificates in Inert Waste Landfill and Treatment of Waste to Produce Soil, Soil Substitutes and Aggregate for both Philip Coplestone and Richard Adams, as requested.

Also attached is a revised version of Table 1a from the Part B4 application form.

I look forward to receiving confirmation that the application has been duly made.

Thank you for your application received on 06/03/2019.

I need to ask you for some missing information before I can do any more work on your application. Please provide us with the following information –

- Please complete questions 7b and 7c of the Part A form.
- You have requested waste code **17 09 04** *mixed construction and demolition wastes other than those mentioned in 17 09 01, 17 09 02 and 17 09 03*. As this is a non-standard waste type for a Deposit for Recovery activity please confirm the types of waste you intend to take under this waste code? For example, will these wastes only be inert waste?

Please note if you intend to use this waste code it would alter your Technically Competent Manager (TCM) requirements. This is due to the application being for a bespoke permit and differing to the waste codes and descriptions in SR2015No39 (as referenced in WAMITAB purpose statement MROC1).

- Please provide relevant Continuing Competency certificates for Jacob Coplestone.

- You've listed two other TCMs, Philip Coplestone and Richard Adams but have only provided Continuing Competence certificates. If you propose to use Philip and Richard as TCMs for the site, as well as Jacob, please provide original qualification certificates for them both.
- Please complete all relevant sections in Table 1a of the Part B4 form. For example, Non-hazardous waste treatment capacity, Total storage Capacity.
