Part B2 – General – new bespoke permit

5c – Provide a non-technical summary of your application

The purpose of this permit application is:

To apply for a bespoke waste recovery permit for the infill of the area outlined in Drawing 1 of the 'Waste Recovery Plan Nov17 – Version 3'. This will be done using approximately 350,000m³ of inert material (700,000 tonnes based on a 2t/m³ conversion). This material will all come under EWC code 17 05 04 – Soils and stones other than those mentioned in 17 05 03.

The Planning Permission states the site is to “be restored to agriculture/amenity/nature conservation in accordance with Policy 9 (Restoration of waste materials and developments) of the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan (2013)”. This Policy states that the “restoration of minerals and waste developments should be in keeping with the character and setting of the local area”. There is therefore a clear need and benefit in restoring the site for future use as a recovery operation.

The site will be infilled progressively – the approved phasing plan has been submitted as part of the application.
