

Appendix 3: Environmental Management Plan (Cedarwood Farm)

K Fresh Ltd is a family run business which has been established since 2001. The business owns a number poultry rearing sites, an existing free range laying unit and a colony laying site. Eggs from the existing free range laying unit and the colony laying site are packed at the Company owned Packing Centre for distribution to retailers and food service groups.

Normal Operations

Birds are checked twice per day by the farm workers. Records of the checks are documented on the House Check Sheet (FF/013), which include the following;

- Feed silo reading
- Feed consumption
- Max/min temperatures
- Water consumption
- Light hours
- Gas meter reading
- Mortality (cull and mortality)
- Hygiene
- Alarm system
- Rodent control
- Structure inspection

Maintenance Schedules and Records

The site is inspected on a monthly basis and recorded on the Monthly Inspection Schedule (FF/024). Checks include the following;

- Internal/external infrastructure (incl. roofs, gutters, fan outlets)
- External draining systems
- General area
- Manhole inspection/discharge points
- Fuel tanks

Complaints System

Accident Management Plan is located at the entrance to the site with details of the permit, emergency contacts etc. Complaints are managed in line with the Complaint Procedure (PR/052). Complaints are recorded and responded to by the Managing Director and Technical Consultant. Documentation relating to complaints are held in the office at the Carr Farm site.

Accidents/Incidents

Accident Management Plan is documented and will be used in the event of an accident or incident. Environmental and Accident Risk Assessment is documented and held in the office at the site.

Training

All staff are appropriately trained prior to commencing work at the site. Staff, visitors and contractors complete the site induction prior to commencing work at the site or visiting the site.

Site Security

The site is accessible by a track which is secured by a gate. Signage is clearly displayed to state that the site is private and no public right of way is permitted. There is CCTV in operation. The houses are locked out of hours.
