

On 11 July 2019, the Environment Agency received an application to vary Transwaste Recycling and Aggregates Limited permit, situated at Melton Waste Park. The Environment Agency advertised the application and consultation responses have been received. These are now being considered along with our technical assessment of the application together with further information received from the operator.

However, during the determination of the variation the operator has proposed changes to the application which we have accepted. The table below outlines the changes and the items that are continuing to be determined.

S5.3 A1 (a) (ii) - Hazardous waste storage and treatment. Also addition of waste code 17 03 01*.	Withdrawn
Leachate storage, together with the addition of EWC codes 19 07 03 and 16 10 02.	Withdrawn
Fragmentiser waste - EWC codes 19 10 04 added to the permit to cover the storage and treatment of up to 60,000 tonnes per year of fragmentiser waste as part of the existing S5.4 A1 (b) (ii) activity.	Withdrawn
Solid Recovered Fuel (SRF) - addition of a drying plant to dry the SRF and adding this as a directly associated activity to the permit.  The site capacity for non-hazardous wastes remains unaffected, this just constitutes a change in the way the wastes are processed.	Continuing to be determined.  The original proposed way of undertaking the drying process and the maximum amount to be dried per day have been amended.  These amended proposals are currently being considered and further information is being sought.

If we are minded to vary the permit then we will consult on our draft decision, otherwise known as a “minded to” decision, before making a final decision. Additional information received will be described in any minded to decision and will be available on the public register.

At that point, we provide an opportunity for comments on our draft decision.
