Thank you for your application received on 30/07/2026.

We need to ask you for some missing information before we can do any more work on your application. Please provide us with more information to the following questions:

1. Airflow consistency across all submitted documents

Please review the airflow rates presented within the application documents and ensure they are consistent and representative of the proposed development. The Ammonia Emissions Impact Assessment states on page 10 that the Munters Reventa Lavamatic XL unit is capable of treating **120,000 m³/h** of air per building. However, the technical specification sheet included as Appendix C of the modelling report states a maximum scrubber capacity of **100,000 m³/h**, whilst DLG Test Report 7561 was undertaken on a Lavamatic XL scrubber operating at an exhaust airflow rate of **110,000 m³/h**. These airflow figures are inconsistent.

Please submit revised versions of the DLG Test Report certification and ammonia modelling report, ensuring that all airflow values are consistent and representative of the proposals submitted with this variation application.

2. Ammonia emissions modelling

Please submit a revised Ammonia Emissions Impact Assessment that clearly explains how the post scrubber ammonia concentrations in the modelling have been derived from DLG Test Report 7561. The modelling should use airflow rates and abatement performance that are representative of the proposed installation and consistent with the supporting DLG Test Report. Please ensure that all assumptions, emission rates, airflow data and supporting calculations are provided within and applied consistently throughout the modelling report and in

line with DLG Test Report.

Please update the ammonia modelling report as relevant to ensure concentrations referenced from DLG report are utilised.

These are the minimum requirements to allow the application to be validated /duly made.

You must send us the information by 11/09/2026.

If we do not receive this by this deadline we will return your application.

If we receive what is missing by the deadline, we will continue to check your application. We'll check to see if there's enough information for the application to be 'duly made'. Duly made means that we have all the information we need to begin determination. Determination is where we assess your application and decide if we can allow what you've asked for.

We'll let you know by email whether your application can be duly made. If it can't be duly made, we'll return your application to you.

If we do have to return your application we'll send you a partial refund of your application payment. We'll retain 20% of the correct application charge to cover our costs in reviewing your application. This maximum amount we'll retain is capped at £1,673.78.
