### Revisions 24/7/24

1. The '**for information only**' List of Waste codes listed at page 4, **given in blue type** to be **added** for the 'Waste Transfer' activity AR3; has been revised to remove the Hazardous, Clinical and WEEES codes, which have been listed within their specific sections of the 'Lists'.

2. Similarly, The extended List of Waste codes (including the additions **given in blue type**) now forming the **NEW list of wastes for the 'Waste Transfer' activity AR3**, listed at page 5; has been revised **to remove/relocate the Hazardous, Clinical and WEEES codes.**

*[For clarity, some waste **types** included in the 'AR7 Clinical List, may also be listed in the 'AR3 Waste Transfer' list, because they may be derived from a different **source***

3. Wastes that are WEES have been removed from the AR5 Waste Treatment List.

4. A subset list of WEEES codes has been provided and named **AR3-WEEES.**

5. Attention has been given to the lists of **AR7 Clinical Wastes** and **AR8 Hazardous Wastes**, so that 'Hazardous Waste' types that are **specifically** derived from 'Clinical' sources (18 xx yy) now only appear in the Clinical Waste Section AR7.
