

# **Leicester City Council- City Highways**

## **Non-Technical Summary**

Ref: LCC.PT.NTS.2407

Leicester City Council- City Highways is seeking to vary their current permit to a bespoke permit for a highways waste transfer station at 90 Castle Park Depot, Leycroft Road, Leicester, Leicestershire, LE4 1BZ. This site is currently operating under permit ref: KP3490CH. The variation is to include:

- the handling of highways waste contaminated with coal tar
- increase the quantity of waste stored on the site at any one time
- vary the layout of the site
- extend the permit boundary

The operations will be subject to the Environmental Permitting Regulations.

A maximum of no more than 25,0000 tonnes will be accepted per annum. The site will handle both hazardous and non-hazardous waste.

The site is designed to allow for the sorting and storage of general waste, highways waste, green waste, and scrap metal. The permitted area site within a larger site which is controlled and managed by Leicester City Council. This site is fully secure with perimeter fencing and access gates.

The site is not open to public. The operating times are outlined below:

Monday – Friday: 06:00 – 18:00

Saturday – Sunday: As required

### **Non-Hazardous Waste**

The non-hazardous waste consists of highways waste not containing coal tar, green waste, general waste, and scrap metal. Waste types are outlined in the EWC codes table below.

### **Hazardous Waste**

The hazardous waste consists of highways waste contaminated with coal tar. Waste types are outlined in the EWC codes table below.
