Table 1 - Aggregates and soils

Waste types for the permit variation are those in line with the replaced Standard rules SR2008No11_75kte - inert and excavation waste transfer station with treatment.

In line with SR2008No 11 the annual treatment capacity will be 75,000 tonnes.

The extra tonnage allocated to SR2022 No 1 is not required.

There no changes to the activities on site.

Waste Types

In line with SR2008No 11 the waste types are those listed below.

Treatment Techniques

Aggregates / soils / sweepings

Treatment techniques
Treatment consisting only of manual sorting, mechanical separation, mechanical screening, trommeling and mechanical crushing of waste into different components for disposal, (no more than 50 tonnes per day) or recovery.

Exclusions

Exclusions Wastes having any of the following characteristics shall not be accepted:

- Consisting solely or mainly of dusts, powders or loose fibres
- Wastes that are in a form which is either sludge or liquid.
