2. Condition of the land at permit issue

Geology

The bedrock geology is sandstone.

Hydrogeology

The Environment Agency groundwater vulnerability map classifies the area under the site as having medium

vulnerability.

There are no wells, springs or boreholes within 50 metres of the site boundary used for the supply of water

for human consumption.

The site is not located in a surface water Nitrate

Vulnerable Zone.

Surface waters

The nearest surface water is Wortley Beck which runs approximately 560 metres to the north east of the site.

Pollution history

This site has never had the benefit of a waste

management permit or licence and as such no pollution

relating to breaches of permit have occurred.

The site has previously been used for manufacture and warehousing. The rear yard has most recently been used

to store pallets.

Historic contamination

The buildings on site are concreted throughout and the

external yard area id partially concreted.

Baseline data

No baseline data for the site exists. The site operators acknowledge that contamination may be present in the unsurfaced areas of the rear yard and accept liability for remediation of the site should they wish to surrender the permit at some point in the future.
