Thank you for your application received on 09/09/2025.
I need to ask you for some missing information before we can do any more work on your application. Please complete and/or provide us with more information to the following questions:

1. The site plan provided is insufficient. The following features should be provided/identified:
 - a. The location of where it is and defining nearby features e.g. road names with a scale for context
 - b. All emission points – including to air (including odour), to water, and all inspection / monitoring locations
 - c. Raw material storage locations
 - d. Entrances / exits
 - e. A surface drainage plan (including foul) is also required
2. More detail is required on the infrastructure considered (secondary containment, tank specification, surfacing etc.)
3. Please provide the maximum amount of raw material at any one time on site.
4. Please provide the raw materials usage efficiency techniques that will be implemented.
5. Noise Management Plan
 - a. Despite the outcome of the Noise Impact Assessment being low risk, this is based on the implementation of mitigation which in this case is the design of the building. If a lower specification was used for the building walls/roof, then the impacts could be higher, so this information needs to be documented in an NMP. Additionally, there are assumptions made regarding sound source levels for the plant, which need to be documented in an NMP. Please provide a NMP which includes the following as a minimum:
 - i. Sound insulation performance specifications in octave frequency bands (Rw dB) for the roof, walls and doors associated with the

- EfW building.
- ii. Sound power levels for the proposed plant in octave frequency bands (Rw dB).

I've included a NMP template which you can also refer to.

6. Environmental Risk Assessment

- a. Please confirm the following missing information:
 - i. The source and what is expected to be within the effluent and any other discharge which is discharged via the sewer (S1)?
- b. Please provide the modelling files used for the Human Health Risk Assessment.

7. Air emissions risk assessment

- a. Several model files with different titles were sent over in the application. Please confirm which model file was used for the dispersion modelling report.
- b. Provide the emission rates (in g/s) for the proposed facility at:
 - i. The emission limit values (ELVs) listed in Table B1 of Annex B of the AQA report; and
 - ii. The half-hourly ELVs listed in section 5.3 of the AQA report.

8. The BAT assessment provided is missing the following information:

- a. Calculations behind how the boiler efficiency figure was calculated
- b. Details of the flue gas cooling method to be used and justification for this choice

9. A payment for the FPP has been provided but this is included in the base application fee, there will be a refund for this.

10. The site has the potential to be of HPI which is in discussion internally. This will be clarified ASAP but it won't hold up the Duly Making process. Either way, the site will need to be published in the newspaper to inform the local public. An additional fee of £538 is required for the Advertising of this site in line with page 17 of our charging scheme. This will be worked out in combination with the refund for the overpayment of the FPP and we will be in touch about this further down the line.

Please reply directly to this email with your information.

You must send us the information within 10 working days of this letter (**21/11/2025**). If we do not receive the information within 10 working days, we will return your application.

If we do receive the requested information and payment within 10 working days, we'll continue to check your application. We'll check to see if there's enough information for the application to be 'duly made'. Duly made means that we have all the information we need to begin determination. Determination is where we assess your application and

decide if we can allow what you've asked for.

We'll let you know by letter whether your application can be duly made. If it can't be duly made, we'll return your application to you.

If we do have to return your application, we'll send you a partial refund of your application payment. We'll retain 20% of the application charge to cover our costs in reviewing your application and requesting information. The maximum amount we'll retain is capped at £1,500. 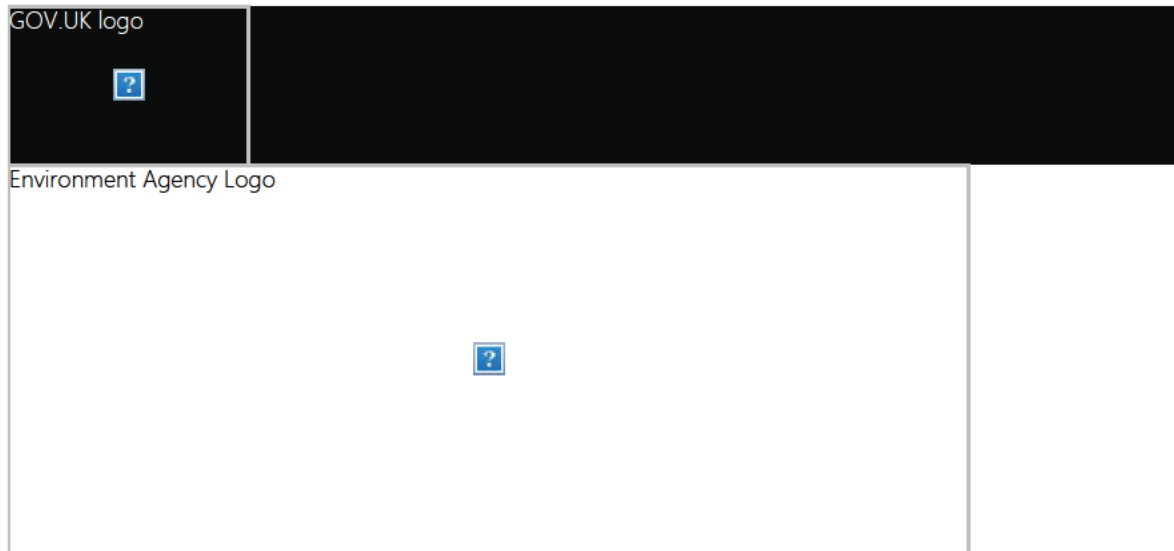

Duly made checks

Once your application is allocated, the permitting officer will check your application. When we are satisfied we have the necessary information to begin our assessment and decision making, your application is considered 'duly made'. We will then begin our technical assessment of your application, we call this the determination stage.

If we need any more information from you at the duly making stage, we will contact you to tell you what additional information you need to submit. You have 5 working days to provide this information. The day after we request it is 'day 1'.

If we are still unable to progress your application any further, we will return it to you. Please note that we will retain part of the correct charge for your application where we have spent time reviewing your application and requesting information. Further details can be found in our [Charging Scheme](#).

When we decide that your application is duly made, we will confirm this by email or letter.

What happens next?

Your application will be allocated for checking and technical assessment as quickly as we can, and we will contact you if we need any further information. If you need to add something, please send it to us at PSC@environment-agency.gov.uk, quoting your application reference.

A permitting officer will check that all relevant information requested in the application forms and application guidance is provided, and will contact you if information is missing.

- Depending on how much information is missing, we may ask you to provide this within a maximum of ten working days. If you do not respond to the request, or what is provided still doesn't meet the requirements, we will return your application.
- If we think there is too much information missing to be provided within 10 working days, we will return your application with a list of what is missing to help you reapply.

If we return your application we will retain 20% of the correct charge for your application, capped at £1,613, to cover our costs in reviewing your application. Further details can be found in our [Charging Scheme](#).

If you have used our enhanced pre application advice service, you must ensure you have paid all associated fees before your application can progress.

Exemptions

Waste exemptions allow low-risk waste management operations to be carried out without an environmental permit.

Future reforms to waste exemptions will mean exemptions cannot be registered at or adjacent to (where there is a direct link) permitted waste operations. Waste exemptions cannot currently be used on a permitted installation.

For further details please read [Waste Exemptions – Getting Ready for Change](#). As part of this work, we are also asking operators to deregister any exemptions no longer used or needed. We do not expect changes to the Environmental Permitting Regulations (EPR) before 2025. This may change as it depends on Parliament and its legislative programme.
