## 1 Introduction

#### 1.1 General

- 1.1.1 Oaktree Environmental Ltd have been instructed to prepare this Non-Technical Summary (NTS) on behalf of Skip Co MCR Limited (the Operator) to support a permit variation application for Environmental Permit Ref. WE9161AA (the Permit).
- 1.1.2 The Permit authorises a household, commercial & industrial waste transfer station with treatment facility in accordance with the requirements of the SR2015 No.6 situated at Trafford Park Road, Trafford Park, Stretford, Manchester, M17 1FR.
- 1.1.3 The Operator is seeking to vary the Permit to bespoke to authorise the external storage and treatment of wastes as detailed in Section 2.1 overleaf.

## **2** Application Proposals

#### 2.1 <u>Variation Proposals</u>

- 2.1.1 The application seeks to vary the permit from Standard Rules to Bespoke, the site will continue to be operated as a household, commercial and industrial (HCI) waste transfer station with treatment facility with waste being separated into different components for disposal (no more than 50 tonnes per day) or recovery.
- 2.1.2 The main change to operations at the site will be the external storage and treatment of non-specified wastes.
- 2.1.3 There are no proposed changes to the treatment activities that are already undertaken on site which comprise of the following:
  - a) Sorting (with loading shovel/360° excavator or by hand).
  - b) Manual separation (by picking line).
  - c) Screening (by using appropriate mechanical screening plant and equipment).
  - d) Baling (by using appropriate mechanical plant and equipment).
  - e) Crushing (by using appropriate mechanical plant and equipment).
  - f) Storage (prior to removal).
- 2.1.4 Sorting, trommel and manual separation of waste will be undertaken within an open fronted building / covered structure. Other than when being treated, all waste will be stored in secure storage bays or sealed containers.
- 2.1.5 All wastes will be stored and treated on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage system, wastes will be stored in accordance with the locations and quantities illustrated on Drawing No. TPR/3455/03.
- 2.1.6 There are no proposed changes to the throughput or types of waste already accepted at the site in accordance with the SR2015 No.6.

2.1.7 There are no proposed changes to the permit boundary.

## 2.2 <u>Limits of Activities</u>

2.2.1 The following limits of activities are set out in the tables below:
