

**Resource Efficiency and climate change - measures for improving energy efficiency of activities at  
Trafford Park EPR/XP3792CT/V003**

S Norton complies with the Energy Saving Opportunity Scheme (ESOS) Phase 2 (2019) and provides annual Streamline Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR) returns.

S Norton also complies with 'ESOS compliant' energy and transport audits of their significant energy uses. In 2019, an energy and transport audit (report and findings attached separately in Appendix F) was carried out for the S Norton wider group and identified measures that could be taken to demonstrate compliance with ESOS and further steps to demonstrate additional energy efficiency measures.

Measures relevant to the Trafford Park facility included:

1. Notify Environment Agency of compliance with ESOS via the portal;
2. Installation of smart sub-metering with efficient data collection, helping to reduce energy consumption with efficient energy data monitoring and analysis;
3. Implement a site wide energy awareness programme, linked to a draft energy policy, that will help improve employee energy awareness, making energy consumption transparent and within employee control;
4. Review space heating and comfort cooling controls and adjust to the standards suggested;  
and
5. Put in place a project management team to support the implementation of recommendations made in this report.

S Norton notified the EA of compliance with ESOS via the portal and reviewed space heating and comfort cooling controls and adjusted to the standards suggested regarding point 1 and 4 respectively.

With regards to point 2, S Norton have recently started a project to add smart sub metering to our static plant. With regards to point 3 and 5, S Norton are in the process of setting up a sustainability working group which will include these measures within its remit.
