I'm writing to let you know that your application is duly made as of 13/03/2026. 'Duly made' means that we have all the information we need to start determination. Determination is where we assess and make a decision on your application.

Your application will be allocated to a determining officer as soon as possible. Once allocated, the officer will contact you to let you know.

From our initial checks, it's likely that we'll need to ask you for further information about the annual waste tonnages for the two activities on site, and the site drainage and consent to discharge to foul sewer. We'll contact you about this and any other items during determination, though it is advisable that when the consent to discharge to foul sewer is obtained the details are provided as soon as possible to support the application. We'll explain what we need and how long you have to provide it.
