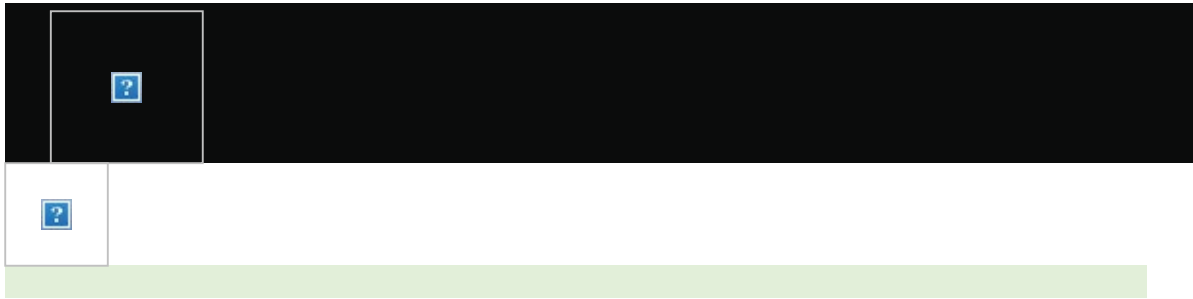

I'm writing to let you know that your application is duly made as of 15/12/2025. 'Duly made' means that we have all the information we need to start determination. Determination is where we assess and make a decision on your application.

Your application will be allocated to a determining officer as soon as possible. Once allocated, the officer will contact you to let you know.

From our initial checks, it's likely that we'll need to ask you for further information about your Environmental Risk Assessment and Dust and Emissions Management Plan. Your Environmental Risk Assessment says the site is in Flood Zone 1 but it is in Flood Zone 3, so you will need to amend this and may need to propose further mitigation measures. You may need to amend your Dust and Emissions Management Plan to show visual monitoring points and provide further justification for why you do not have a wheelwash. We'll contact you about this and any other items during determination. We'll explain what we need and how long you have to provide it.
