Hi Joanne

I can confirm that as per your question 13 below, the site will not process more than 75 tonnes per day of all waste types per day for recovery, alone or in aggregate.

I have also looked into the issue of the small area of land to the north of the site. It appears that this was a late addition to incorporate the site office. If you could check your correspondence to see how this came about that would be helpful as in the first 5 versions of the site layout plan it was not included within the permitted area. I have attached version 5 and 6 of the site layout plans showing when that change came about.

Please see our answers in **Red** below.

1. Clarification of the proposed permitted area boundary. You want to add land to the original permitted area. However the shape of the original part of the permitted area is different on your site plan 230810LLS102 (attached) compared to the current permit (attached). In the permit the line at the top isn't straight. It sticks out at the left top corner. In your site plan this line is straight. Please confirm the correct boundary of the permitted area and amend the site plan if necessary. **The site plan 230810LLS102 is correct.**
2. Provide an amended Environmental Risk Assessment that includes the Local Wildlife Site and protected species. **Our ERA now includes the sites we are aware of, 1 SSSI, Lea Valley (River Lea Navigation) and 2 sites of interest to nature conservation; Lea Valley & the Salmon and Montague Recreation Ground. Are they all of the sites you are referring to? I have attached the amended ERA**

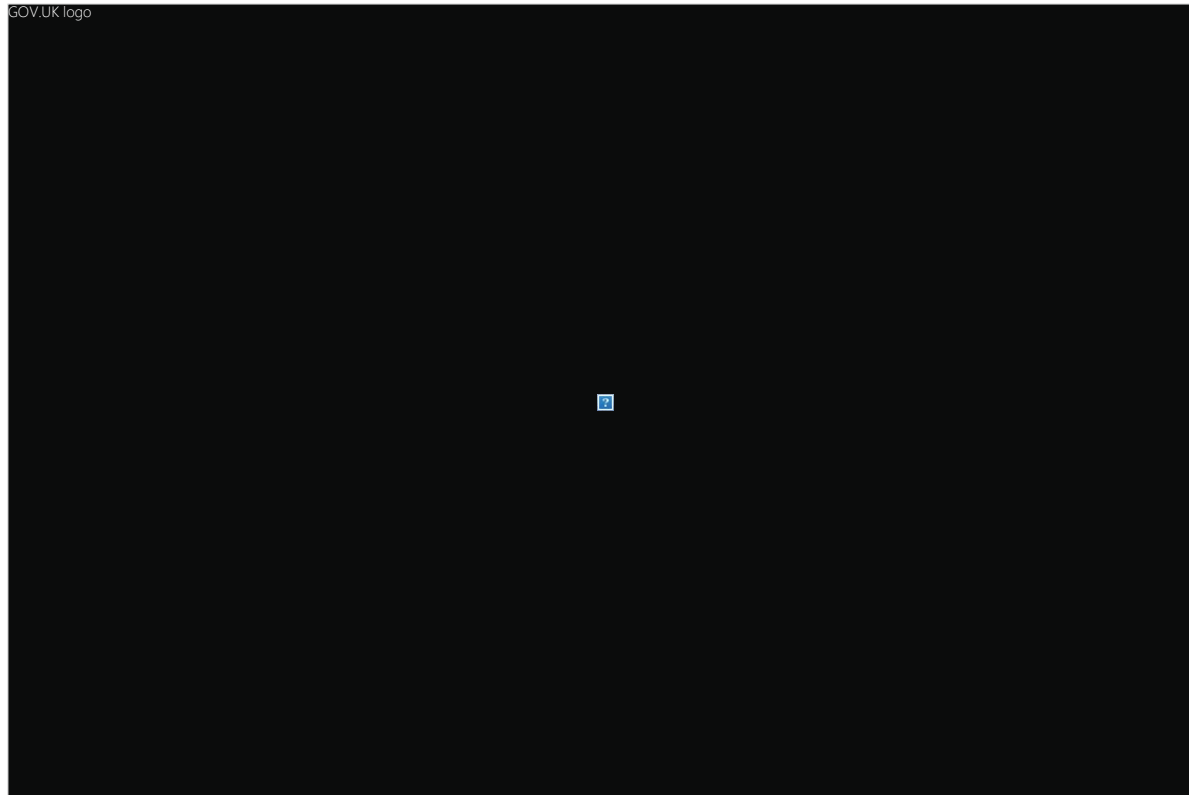

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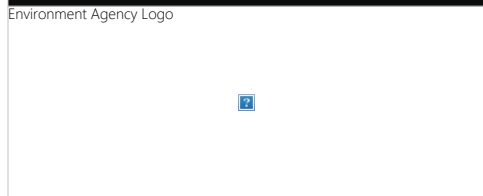

If we do not receive this by this deadline we will return your application.

If we receive what is missing by the deadline, we will continue to check your application. We'll check to see if there's enough information for the application to be 'duly made'. Duly made means that we have all the information we need to begin determination. Determination is where we assess your application and decide if we can allow what you've asked for.

We'll let you know by email whether your application can be duly made. If it can't be duly made, we'll return your application to you.

If we do have to return your application we'll send you a partial refund of your application payment. We'll retain 20% of the correct application charge to cover our costs in reviewing your application. This maximum amount we'll retain is capped at £1,613. We have also identified the following missing information, which although it will not prevent us from duly making the application, will be required during determination. You should provide this information as early as possible to avoid delays during determination.

- Further information is required for the Dust and Emissions Management Plan (DEMP). For example, the visual monitoring points are not shown on the site layout plan and you may need to provide further justification for why you do not have a wheelwash.

Without this additional information we will be unable to issue your permit.
