Carcasses will be incinerated on site in a licensed incinerator with a capacity not exceeding 50kg/hr. Incinerator use is listed in Tech standards, Non Tech summary, OMP and the application form B3.5. Have revised the Contingency Document to show a collection agent used in the event of incinerator failure.

Accident Assessment and Routine Maintenance Documents amended.

Efflux velocity of roof fans 12m/s as per pre application report, shown on layout plan.

Water usage - operator will be applying for a borehole abstraction license, expected usage at peak demand 60m3 per day with mains back up, location not yet determined.

Thank you for your application received on 04/04/22.

I need to ask you for some missing information before I can do any more work on your application. Please provide us with the following:

- You have an incinerator marked on the drainage plan and it is listed in the emissions table in the technical standards document - however this is not mentioned elsewhere. Please confirm if there is an incinerator on site. The documents contradict themselves. Are carcasses incinerated on-site or are they taken off-site by a third party?
- The accident risk assessment and routine maintenance schedule documents are not site specific and have a different farm name. Provide site specific versions of these documents.
- In section 6b of the application form (Form B3.5) you have indicated the site's water use is from 'surface water or groundwater abstraction'. Please confirm which it is, and provide information regarding where this will be abstracted from, how much will be abstracted, and any controls you will have in place for this.
- Please confirm the efflux velocity for the roof fans.
