Thanks for responding so quickly

So just a few final points :

1. **Tech standards document:** unlined pond acting as soakaway within boundary , count as land emissions so table just needs update that there is unlined pond and french drains for poultry houses 1-6 and similar set for poultry houses 7-8

Done and attached

2. **MCP;** Also, if accurate that standby generator is truly with thermal input capacity > 1MW then Medium Combustion Plant Directive applies

Follow on questions are

- When was generator first used linked to this installation, if before December '18 classed as new plant. The farm was built in 2021 and came to us in 2022 with a 453KVA (1.087MWth?) and a 450KVA (1.080MWth?) generator installed. The generators are listed in Table S3.1
- Monitoring: If MCP applies then monitoring of carbon monoxide and oxides of nitrogen in line with low risk MCP guidance is required:

I've requested the company that has the maintenance contract for all of our standby generators to confirm if they meet the requirements or, if not, what modifications are required in order to meet the new requirements by the deadline. Either way, we will ensure that they are compliant by the appropriate deadline.

3. Ammonia assessment

We will carry out a screening based on information submitted

We will confirm if modelling actually needed and any specific requirements/need for modelling files

Look forward to responses and we will confirm ammonia assessment conclusion as soon as possible

From your follow-on emails- many thanks for confirming that additional ammonia modelling/assessment is not required.

I have updated the site map as requested and attached to this email with the following modifications:

Clean water in blue

Dirty water in red

Storm drainage/ runoff protection in magenta

House numbers and floor sizes text increased in size

Soakaways renamed as French drains

Attenuation ponds labelled

Regarding the RWH, the first pond was fitted with a RWH system with all backflush residues piped directly to tank as per the site attached map but this feature has not been used since it was built and there is currently no intention of utilising it going forward. The only chemical recommended by the manufacturer to be used in the RWH system would be hypochlorite in low concentrations as the system relies mainly on graduated filtration followed by UV sterilisation. There is no intention of adding RWH capability to the second attenuation pond.

If the above is satisfactory to get the RWH added to the permit for potential use for the RWH to be utilised for the washing out of the poultry houses during turnaround then great, If not, then we probably won't bother trying to get it added on as there is no appetite within our veterinary team to utilise the RWH as a source of potable water for the birds themselves.
